

## Myton School Uniform September 2022 (Years 7-11 only)

Following consultation with parents, carers, students and staff, the governors ratified the uniform for Myton School (for Years 7-11) in March 2022. Please see separate details for Sixth Form uniform which was ratified by governors in April 2022.

### Uniform for ALL students in Years 7-11:

Branded blazer				<b>OPTIONAL:</b> Black V-neck jumper		
Tie (current Upper School style)				<div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 10px;"> <p><u>Timing:</u></p> <p>September 2022 – This uniform will be worn by new Year 7 intake only.</p> <p>Throughout academic year 2022-23, new uniform purchases will move towards this uniform.</p> <p>September 2023 – all students in Years 7-11 will be expected to wear this uniform.</p> </div>		
White shirt (Long or short sleeved)						
Black trousers or Black pleated skirt (no shorter than 10cm above knee)						
Black leather-style shoes (no logos)						
Black, grey or white socks (not patterned)						

**PE Uniform for ALL students in Years 7-11:**

Red polo shirt with Myton branding			OPTIONAL: Rugby top with Myton branding		
Black shorts or skort			OPTIONAL: Fleece with Myton branding		
Black games socks White trainer socks			OPTIONAL: Plain black tracksuit bottoms (no logos or stripes)		
Astro boots			OPTIONAL: Black base layer worn below top or shorts/skort – (e.g. black leggings/black top)		
			OPTIONAL: Football boots for use on the field  Trainers for indoors  <b><i>Astro boots CAN be worn instead</i></b>		

**Other uniform rules:**

Hair: No **extreme** hairstyles, including colours/cuts.

Jewellery: A single stud earring in each ear; no facial piercings including nose studs; no other jewellery permitted.

Nails: No coloured nail varnish or acrylic nails allowed. Nails should be kept to a sensible length that will not affect safety and participation in PE, other practical subjects, or a student's ability to write.

Make up: must be light and insignificant.
