Themes: Describing your home, ideal home, town and area Grammar: Negative phrases with <i>de</i>, the conditional voice, demonstrative adjectives, possessive pronouns, reviewing prepositions and the conditional and superlative/adjectival agreement Linguistic skills: Building longer sentences and using intensifiers How students will be assessed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Speaking Assessment: General Conversation (one topic). Past exam questions based on Module 3. 	<p><u>Module 4: Festivals</u></p> <p>What will be learnt? Themes: How to discuss how we celebrate key occasions and the importance of them, describing international festivals and a special event Grammar: Reflexive verbs in the perfect tense, using the perfect infinitive, using imperfect and perfect tense Linguistic skills: Making use of social and cultural context when interpreting meaning How students will be assessed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Listening, Reading and Writing. Past exam questions based on Modules 1, 2, 3 and 4. 	<p><u>Module 5: Holidays</u></p> <p>What will be learnt?
