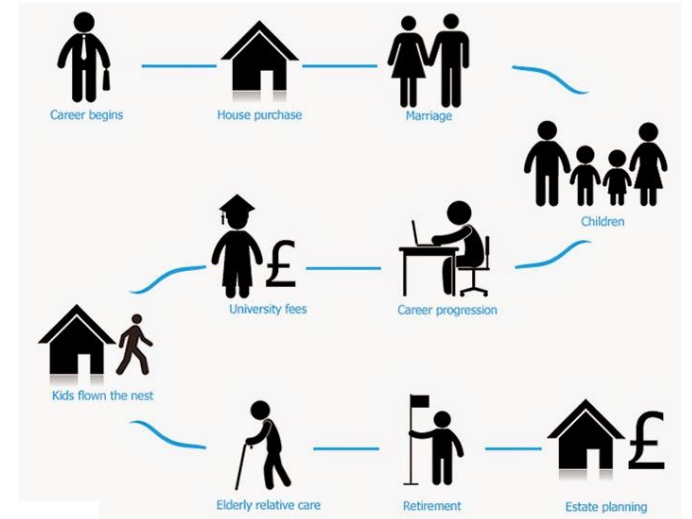
- a) What facilities can you offer?
