Year 10 Work Experience 2025

As part of our careers programme at Myton School we offer work experience to all Year 10 students. We recognise the importance of students having the opportunity to participate in a high-quality work experience as a valuable part of preparation for Year 11 as it provides young people with:

- increased self-understanding, maturity, independence, and self-confidence
- increased motivation to continue study and/or undertake further training
- an understanding of the work environment and what employers expect of their employees
- an opportunity to explore possible career options and “try out” a workplace
- a better understanding of how the school curriculum can help prepare young people for work
- enhanced opportunities for part-time and casual employment
- the opportunity to include the employer's work experience evaluation in future job and course applications
- opportunities to develop work-related competencies and acquire new skills

The work experience programme will take place between 30 June – 4 July 2025. Students will be encouraged to find their own work experience placement to develop their employability skills and time will be allocated during tutor time to assist with this.

To support students with their post-16 choices and career opportunities, it would be most beneficial if they were able to source a placement linked to an area of interest. We may be able to provide support if your child is struggling to find a placement but initially, we encourage students/carers to try and find a work experience placement.

Through our partnership with Work Experience Services (Warks) all work experience placements will be checked for all aspects of health and safety to ensure that correct insurances/policies are in place for students under the age of 16. There will be a charge of £17.00 per student for these checks to be conducted. A voluntary contribution of £17.00 should be made via ParentPay when your child submits their placement details. This can be done by clicking [HERE](#) or by handing in a paper copy of the form to your child's tutor. ParentPay will be live for payments from 9am on Thursday 17 October 2024.

By making payment via ParentPay, you give consent for your child to participate in this event and declare that your child is in good health and physically able to take part. If there are any changes to your child's medical status which were not declared on the Pupil Data Checking Sheet, as issued at the start of the academic year, you must notify the school immediately.

If you **DO NOT** wish for your child to take part in this experience, please contact Mr Wilson to discuss in further detail. This information is required by Monday 27 January 2025 at the latest and students should either submit placement details online or give their completed placement form to their tutor by this date.
